

# Public Transport in and around Bangor



## **Buses**

Bangor Bus Station is located on Garth Road (next to Marks and Spencer). Each route has a number, which is displayed at the bus stop and on the bus itself. The main bus service operating in Bangor is **Arriva**. Timetables can be obtained at the bus station or on the bus services' website: [www.arrivabus.co.uk](http://www.arrivabus.co.uk) or on the local Council website [www.gwynedd.gov.uk](http://www.gwynedd.gov.uk) under 'Parking, Road & Travel'.
