- The project involves the demolition of the non-Listed building extensions, whist constructing an efficient new build element and refurbishing the Listed Building.

The Albert Gubay Charitable Foundation provided a £10.5 million donation to establish the Albert Gubay Business School at Bangor university



Existing Site Plan









